Indoor Air Quality

The Parkers Prairie Public School District has written an indoor air quality (IAQ) management plan that describes our on-going effort to monitor and improve the air quality in our buildings. IAQ coordinator Roger Rewitzer is responsible for seeing that the management plan is implemented to prevent as many IAQ problems as possible and to quickly respond to any IAQ problems that may arise. The plan is available to the public during normal school hours.

Asbestos Notification

In accordance with federal regulations, Parkers Prairie Public School District has management plans documenting the location and condition of all known or assumed asbestos containing materials (ACM) in each building. Every six months, the ACM is visually inspected. The Parkers Prairie High School and Elementary site management plans are available for public inspection at the district office during normal office hours. Roger is the designated person responsible for maintaining the asbestos management plans for the district.

Pesticide Notice

Pesticide application for Parkers Prairie Public Schools will occur spring through fall. Long-term health effects on children from the application of such pesticides or the class of chemicals to which they belong may not be fully understood. The majority of the District's applied pesticides are completed by licensed commercial applicators.
