

## **ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY**

The Parkers Prairie School Districts offers a wide variety of opportunities to participate in extra-curricular activities. Academic success, sportsmanship, and adherence to School District rules are essential components of students' ability to participate in District-sponsored programs.

In order to be eligible to practice and compete on athletic teams and in extra-curricular activities, students must meet the following requirements.

- Students must be in “good academic standing” and maintain “satisfactory progress” as defined by their classroom teachers.
- Students will be required to do one, or more of the following when not in “good academic standing”:
  - Attend Targeted Services
  - Attend the Resource Room Services
  - Attend Saturday School
  - Meet any requirements necessary to make “good academic standing” for the class

This policy will not affect a student's ability to participate in activities in which participation accounts for a portion of each student's grade for the class.
